Tena koe ara koutou katoa,

As part of the development of Te Pou Tarāwaho Mātauranga o Ngāti Kahu (the Ngati Kahu Indigenous Qualification Framework), Te Rūnanga-ā-Iwi o Ngāti Kahu has launched an initiative aimed at lifting the proficiency and numbers of our **kai mihimihi** and **kai karanga**.

Te Kura Reo o Ngāti Kahu is a 9 month, 4 level course of learning based upon the teachings of our tūpuna as passed on to us by our rangatira Makari Matiu and others. It is not for beginner level students.¹

Contact class time is fortnightly Wednesday evenings from 5.30 – 6.30 pm in the conference room at Te Rūnanga-ā-Iwi o Ngāti Kahu.

The head tutors are Te Ikanui Kingi-Waiaua and Reremoana Renata.
