SAFER SPEED REVIEW Consultation October 2019



Awanui to Kaingaroa



We want to make your roads safer for everyone who uses them. On some roads we're doing this with safety improvements, but on State Highway 10 between Awanui and Kaingaroa, Northland the best thing we can do to prevent people from dying or being seriously injured is reduce speed limits, so they are safe and right for the road.

Speed increases both the likelihood of crashes and the severity of crashes when they happen. A small reduction in speed can make a big difference, especially when cyclists or pedestrians are involved. Most crashes are caused by a number of factors, but even when speed is not the cause of a crash, it will most likely determine whether anyone is killed, injured or walks away unharmed.

Formal consultation on the new speed limit proposals is required under the Land Transport Rule: Setting of Speed Limits (2017).

WHAT WE HAVE HEARD

We have talked to the community, council, the local police, road user groups and local businesses about the current speed limits between Awanui and Kaingaroa and they have raised concerns that the current speeds feel too high to be safe.

WHAT WE KNOW

People felt lower speeds were justified between Awanui and Kaingaroa. People felt even the proposed 80km/h was not low enough for Kareponia and Kaingaroa. Many people felt 50km/h or 60km/h would be better in these villages. The village of Kareponia has a high risk due to children from the Kōhanga Reo crossing and school buses turning.

There have been 92 crashes on this stretch of road in the last 10 years (2009–2018) resulting in three people being killed, six seriously injured.

Based on current average speeds, if the proposed speeds are put in place, we estimate it will only take you 85 seconds more to travel this stretch of road.
